Winter preparation

Do not park in the snow designated areas or you will be towed during November – March. All parking lots are assigned now. So, if you are a commuter and a member who parks in court A, B or C in the winter while you work, Don't! Parking for the winter may be allowed for registered vehicles of members only at the center from December through March. You must be a registered vehicle of Arrowwood with a viable sticker or you will be towed. If you don't drive in the winter please move your car and clean it off regularly. Let the office know so we won't tag your car for not moving. We need spaces, report members who have more than 2 vehicles. Don't drive behind the trucks while plowing because we can't see you and we want to keep both you and our maintenance team safe.

Possible Carrying Charge increase of \$5.00 for 2015

The Board is working on its budget for 2015. We are an aging facility and next year's budget will be to improve the quality of some of our basic functions such as; upstairs bathroom fan upgrade, replace water shutoffs, threshold refurbishing, back porch lights, major cement project for court C accessibility and revamping the north side of Pontiac Trail and finalization of the exterior light project. The cooperative runs on the carrying charges of members as we are a nonprofit. The budget will be presented in December at the regular Board meeting. A formal notice of increase will be mailed this month if it passes.

Sewer Back Up Prevention

This is the eating and cooking season... please be careful and very diligent about what you put in the toilet and sink. Don't flush the flushable diaper parts, baby wipes, paper towels, feminine napkins, tampons and kitty litter. These products do not degrade and cause back-ups for you and your neighbors. Grease and paper towels are the usual culprits. Be wise, throw it in the garbage. Keep a grease container in your home, then throw it in the dumpster. Be sure to use a lint trap in the washer. The cooperative has the main lines cleaned bi-annually and other areas annually. Do your part and help us prevent sewer backups. **Insurance note: you must add this type of protection as a rider on your policy.**



We would like to pay tribute to a great man Mr. Joe Dulin who helped many children in the community.

-Joseph Dulin a native of Evansville, Ind. Dulin was known for his passion for edu-

cation and improving the lives of students in the Ann Arbor area. Joseph Dulin, was the founding principal of Ann Arbor's Roberto Clemente Stu- dent Development Center. During his long career in Ann Arbor, his reputa- tion as a no-nonsense educator who cared deeply for his students grew so large that a movie was made about his life. The film, "Bridging the Gap". Among the many accomplishments on Dulin's resume was creating Na- tional African American Parent Involvement Day in November 1995 as a way to encourage black parents to become involved with the education of their children. Dulin also served as an advisor to former Vice President Al Gore during Gore's presidential campaign in 2000. Dulin retired in 2009 after spending 52 years involved in education with more than 30 years at the Roberto Clemente Student Development Center, which served students who struggled to be successful in traditional school envi- ronments. Also in 2009, Dulin and his wife established the Joseph & Yvonne Dulin Scholarship Fund that awards a \$500 scholarship to an Afri- can American student who lives and attends high school in Washtenaw County. Last year he was awarded the Martin Luther King, Jr., Humanitari- an Award from Eastern Michigan University.

"A chronically late payment is defined as paying carrying charges after the due date on three or more occasions during the term of this agreement." What exactly does that mean? You can be terminated for late payments. If you have too many vehicles please remove them. If you have added new residents to your household; dogs or people without going through proper procedure, we strongly urge you to clear that up now.
